Sleeping Room Reservations

A block of rooms has been reserved at the W Seattle hotel for the nights of Tuesday, March 10 to Thursday, March 12. The lodging rate is \$188 per night plus sales tax. Reservations need to be made before **February 17, 2026** to receive the rate.

You are responsible for cancelling your hotel reservation if you cannot attend. **The hotel requires notice of cancellation 72 hours prior to your scheduled arrival.** If you fail to provide notice, one night's lodging and tax will be charged to your credit card.

Hotel check-in begins after 4:00 p.m., and check-out time is 12:00 p.m.

What to Pack for the Seattle Area

Average temperatures in March range from 37°F at night to 54°F during the day. Please be advised that the temperatures in the training room do not reflect temperatures outside. Be sure to pack a jacket or sweater to wear while you attend the training.

Dining

The hotel includes 2 dining options on site, Trace Market, serving breakfast, lunch and brunch, and the W Living Room Bar serving drinks. Other restaurants are nearby.

Health, Fitness and Recreation

The hotel is equipped with a fitness and business center.

Travel Information

The Seattle area is served by [Sea-Tac International Airport \(SEA\)](#).

Seattle, Washington is located in the Pacific Time Zone.

Ground Transportation

The Seattle Central Link Light Rail provides access to downtown Seattle from SEA airport. Trains leave SEA every 15 minutes, and the ride is approximately 38 minutes each way. Fares are \$3.50 one-way. Exit at Westlake Station, which is within walking distance of the W Seattle Hotel. Additional information is available at <https://www.soundtransit.org/>

Taxi: Taxi fare between SEA and the hotel is approximately \$45 each way, not including gratuity.

Shuttle Service: There is a private service that operates an airport shuttle, details can be found at <https://premierairportshuttle.com/shared-ride/>

Shared Ride Service: Shared ride services such as Uber and Lyft are available from SEA to the hotel. Fare ranges from \$40 to \$55 one way, depending on time of day and not including gratuity.

Parking: The hotel offers valet parking for about \$68 per night. Paid parking is available in the Park Place Region 10 office building with preferred stalls available for alternative fuel vehicles.
