A bioreactor landfill operates to rapidly transform and degrade organic waste. The increase in waste degradation and stabilization is accomplished through the addition of liquid and air to enhance microbial processes. The overall objective of the bioreactor seminar is to decrease landfill volume and further reduce the need to construct new landfill sites.

Discuss the field studies and laboratory results that investigate effectiveness of mechanisms designed to degrade municipal waste.
