

# FIELD SAMPLING TECHNIQUES WORKSHOP



**Description:** The Field Sampling Techniques Workshop will provide an opportunity for RCRA staff to gain the necessary framework in a consistent and regulatory-based manner. The three day workshop will be held in *Austin, TX* (September 15 - 17, 2008) and *Baton Rouge, LA* (October 21 - 23, 2008). The course will comprise of both classroom sessions/trainings as well as hands-on field exercises.

**Objectives:**

- 1) To provide classroom sessions focused on RCRA Sampling Procedures Handbook;
- 2) To provide effective and complete training for site investigations;
- 3) Address more frequent sampling activities such as Compliance Evaluation Inspections and Environmental Indicators data gap assessments; and,
- 4) Participation in Hands-on field exercises that focus on soil, surface water/sediment, groundwater sampling; and the installation techniques for installation of temporary wells.
