Sleeping Room Reservations

A block of rooms has been reserved at the Hyatt Regency Denver at Colorado Convention Center. The lodging rate is the prevailing government rate of \$149 per night plus 14.75 percent sales tax. Reservations need to be made before **Tuesday**, **July 31**, **2012**, to receive the government rate.

Included under the EPA room block is a complimentary breakfast buffet and complimentary wireless internet access in your sleeping room.

To make your sleeping room reservation by telephone, call (800) 233-1234 and ask for Reservations. Once you provide your arrival and departure dates, you must mention the Group Name U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.

Reservations at the Hyatt Regency must be confirmed with a credit card.

You are responsible for cancelling your hotel reservation if you cannot attend. The Hyatt Regency requires a notice of cancellation by 3:00 p.m. Mountain Time, 48 hours before the day of your scheduled arrival. If you fail to provide notice, one night's lodging and tax will be charged to your credit card.

Upon check-in you will be asked to verify your departure date; if you check-out earlier from your verified departure date, an early departure fee of one night's lodging and tax will be charged to your credit card.

Hotel check-in begins after 3:00 p.m., and check-out time is at 11:00 a.m.



What to Pack for the Denver Area

Dress is casual for Denver weather. Temperatures range from 54°F at night to 85°F during the day. Please be advised that the temperatures in the training room do not reflect temperatures outside. Be sure to pack a light jacket or sweater to wear while you attend the training course.

Dining and Entertainment

- Room service is available from 6:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m. daily.



Ground Transportation


Super Shuttle provides service from the airport to the Hyatt Regency. Super Shuttle runs approximately every 15 minutes between the hours of 5:00 a.m. to 5:15 p.m. Ticket counters are located on Terminal Level 5, across from the rental car agencies; reservations are not required. The cost is \$22 per person each way or \$40 per person round trip. For more information or to make reservations, contact Super Shuttle directly at (800) 258-3826 or (303) 316-3865. Super Shuttle features blue vans with SUPER SHUTTLE printed on the side.

Taxi fare between DEN and the hotel is approximately \$55 each way, not including gratuity.

Self-parking is available at the Hyatt Regency for \$25 per night with in and out privileges. Valet parking is available for \$30 per night.



Driving Directions from DEN to the Hyatt Regency Denver at Colorado Conference Center



From DEN Airport Approximately 25 miles, 40 minutes

- Exit the airport and follow signs to Pena Boulevard and I-70 West
- Merge onto I-70 West
- ❖ Take Exit 274 toward I-25 South
- Follow signs for Park Avenue/Downtown
- Merge onto Fox Street/Park Avenue West
- Continue to follow Park Avenue West
- Continue onto 22nd Street
- Make a slight right onto Broadway
- Turn right onto Glenarm Place
- Turn right onto 15th Street
- Hotel will be on the left

16th Street Shuttle
