Various parking garages surround the EPA Region 6 Office to the north, east and south. Participants can park in the surrounding garages if necessary. Parking rates vary per garage.

Sleeping Room Reservations

A block of rooms has been reserved at The Adolphus Hotel in Dallas, Texas. The lodging rate is the prevailing government rate of \$113 per night plus 15 percent sales tax. Reservations need to be made before **5:00 p.m. Central Time on Friday, September 13, 2013**, to receive the government rate.

Included under the EPA room block is complimentary Internet access in your sleeping room, complimentary continental breakfast, 10 percent vouchers to hotel restaurants, and courtesy car transportation within a 3 mile radius of the hotel.

You are responsible for cancelling your hotel reservation if you cannot attend. The Adolphus Hotel requires a notice of cancellation by 5:00 p.m. Central Time, 24 hours before the day of your scheduled arrival. If you fail to provide notice, one night's lodging and tax will be charged to your credit card.

Upon check-in you will be asked to verify your departure date; if you check-out earlier from your verified departure date, an early departure fee of \$100 will be charged to your credit card.

Hotel check-in begins after 3:00 p.m., and check-out time is at 1:00 p.m.

What to Pack for the Dallas Area

Dress is casual for Dallas weather. Temperatures range from 60°F at night to 80°F during the day. Please be advised that the temperatures in the training room do not reflect temperatures outside. Be sure to pack a jacket or sweater to wear while you attend the Superfund 101 Training.

Dining

The Adolphus Hotel offers several on-site restaurants:

Travel Information

The Dallas area is served by Dallas/Fort Worth International Airport (DFW). DFW is located approximately 20 miles from downtown Dallas, Texas. Additional information for DFW is available at www.dfwairport.com.

Dallas Love Field Airport (DAL) is located approximately 8 miles from downtown Dallas, Texas. Additional information for DAL is available at www.dallas-lovefield.com.

Dallas, Texas is located in the Central Time Zone.

Ground Transportation

GO Yellow Checker Shuttle provides transportation from both DFW and DAL to the Adolphus Hotel. After you claim your luggage, locate the loading zones for boarding the GO Yellow Checker Shuttle van just outside from baggage claim on the Baggage Claim level.

Reservations are required and can be made at http://www.yellowcheckershuttle.com/epa. GO Yellow Checker Shuttle is offering a special rate discount for our group. If pre-purchased, one-way fare between DFW or DAL and the Adolphus Hotel is \$17 and round-trip fare between DFW or DAL and the Adolphus is \$32. This is a shared ride service which means that the driver has 25 minutes on airport property from the time the first passenger is placed in the vehicle. Taxi fare between DFW and the hotel is approximately \$40 each way, not including gratuity. Taxi fare between DAL and the hotel is approximately \$20 each way, not including gratuity.

Valet parking is available at the hotel for \$26 per night with in and out privileges.



Driving Directions to EPA Region 6 Dallas

From DFW Airport Approximately 20 miles, 27 minutes

- Take the South Exit from the airport
- ❖ Take the TX-183 E ramp towards Dallas/Irving
- Merge onto TX-183 E
- ❖ TX-183 E merges into I-35 E
- ❖ Take the exit towards I-45/US-75/Houston
- Merge onto Woodall Rogers Freeway
- ❖ Take the first exit, Field Street/Griffin Street
- Keep left at fork on ramp and merge onto N. Griffin Street (move to left lane)
- Turn left at the first light onto Ross Avenue
- The EPA is located in the glass office building at the corner of Ross Avenue and Field Street

From DAL Airport

Approximately 8 miles, 12 minutes

- Exit airport and take a right onto Mockingbird
- Continue westbound on Mockingbird to I-35 E
- ❖ Take the exit towards I-45/US-75/Houston
- Merge onto Woodall Rogers Freeway
- ❖ Take the first exit, Field Street/Griffin Street
- Keep left at fork on ramp and merge onto N. Griffin Street (move to left lane)
- Turn left at the first light onto Ross Avenue
- The EPA is located in the glass office building at the corner of Ross Avenue and Field Street

Walking Directions to EPA Region 6 Dallas

From The Adolphus Hotel Approximately 0.5 miles, 10 minutes

- ❖ Head west on Commerce Street for 300 feet
- Turn right onto Field Street and walk 0.3 miles
- Turn right onto Ross Avenue
- The EPA is located in the glass office building at the corner of Ross Avenue and Field Street
