A block of rooms has been reserved at the Residence Inn by Marriott Denver City Center Hotel in Denver, Colorado. The lodging rate is the prevailing government rate of \$181 per night plus sales tax. Included in the room rate is complimentary

breakfast in the Hearth Room and a complimentary evening reception from 6:00 p.m. until 7:30 p.m. Monday through Wednesday.

Reservations need to be made before Thursday, May 23, 2019, to receive the government rate.

You need to mention that you are reserving under the "EPA CEC Superfund 101" group to receive the negotiated lodging rate. Please note, when using the link, you will only be able to book the contracted dates of the room block which are an arrival of Sunday, June 23 and a departure of Saturday, June 29. If you try to book any time before or after those dates, the link will say "no rooms available." If you need dates before or after the block dates, please contact Jodi McCarty, ICF, at <u>Jodi.mccarty@icf.com</u> for assistance.

You are responsible for cancelling your hotel reservation if you cannot attend. The Residence Inn requires a notice of cancellation 48 hours before by 6:00 p.m. local time on the day of your scheduled arrival. If you fail to provide notice, one night's lodging and tax will be charged to your credit card.

Hotel check-in begins after 4:00 p.m., and check-out time is at 11:00 a.m.





What to Pack for the Denver Area

Temperatures range from 50°F at night to 90°F during the day. Please be advised that the temperatures in the training room do not reflect temperatures outside. Be sure to pack a jacket or sweater to wear while you attend the training.

Dining

Travel Information

The Denver area is served by Denver International Airport (DEN). DEN is located approximately 25 miles from downtown Denver, Colorado. Additional information for DEN is available at <u>http://www.flydenver.com/</u>.

Ground Transportation

RTD Rail System: Denver's recently opened RTD Rail System provides service from DEN to downtown Denver. Upon arriving at DEN, head to baggage claim located on Level 5. To get to the Denver Airport RTD Station, follow signs to the Transit Center and proceed to the south exit on level 5 (look for the large American flag), exit the terminal through the sliding glass doors and take the escalator located in the center of the plaza down to Level 1. The A Line Trains depart to and from the airport every 15 minutes throughout the day, 7 days a week, and 365 days a year. Early morning and late evening trips depart every 30 minutes. One-way fares are \$9.00. You must purchase your ticket prior to boarding the train from one of the kiosks located on the platform. To get to the Residence Inn, take the A Line all the way to Union Station (approximately 37 minutes). From Union Station you can walk towards 16th Street and take the 16th Street Shuttle, a free shuttle that travels the 16th Street mall, and get off at the Champa Street stop. The Residence Inn by Marriott Denver City Center is about 15-minutes away by foot from Union Station.

Taxi: Taxi fare between DEN and the Residence Inn by Marriott is approximately \$55 each way, not including gratuity.

Hotel Parking: Parking is available at the hotel for \$35 per night plus tax with in and out privileges.


Walking Directions to EPA Region 8 from the Residence Inn
