Schedule of Events

The Remedial Design/Remedial Action (RD/RA) training course will be held Tuesday, April 4 through Wednesday, April 5, 2023, at the EPA Region 10 office in Seattle, Washington. The training begins at 8:30 a.m. local time on Tuesday and ends at 4:00 p.m. local time on Wednesday. Please plan your travel accordingly.

The EPA Region 10 office is located at: Park Place Building 1200 Sixth Avenue Seattle, Washington 98101

Please note: The training will be held at the EPA Region 10 office in Seattle, Washington on the 21st floor. A sleeping room block has been established at Homewood Suites by Hilton Seattle Pike/Convention Center, which is located approximately 0.5 miles from the EPA Region 10 building, an approximately nine-minute walk. For those driving to the training, paid parking is available in the EPA Region 10 building (Park Place building) with preferred stalls available for alternative fuel vehicles.

You are responsible for cancelling your hotel reservation if you cannot attend. **The Homewood Suites requires a notice of cancellation 24 hours prior to the day of your scheduled arrival.** If you fail to provide notice, one night's lodging and tax will be charged to your credit card.

Hotel check-in begins after 4:00 p.m., and check-out time is at 12:00 p.m.

What to Pack for the Seattle Area

Average temperatures in April in Seattle range from 43°F to 60°F. Please be advised that the temperatures in the training room do not reflect temperatures outside. Be sure to pack a jacket or sweater to wear while you attend the training.

Dining and Other Amenities

The hotel includes the following amenities:

- A free hot breakfast is served daily at the hotel.
- Within one block are Starbucks Reserve, Melrose Market, and a variety of fresh seafood and dining options.

- Fitness center. The pool is currently closed until May 25, 2023.

Travel Information

The Seattle area is served by Sea-Tac International Airport (SEA). SEA is located approximately 15 miles from downtown Seattle, Washington and approximately 17 miles from the hotel. Additional information for SEA is available at http://www.portseattle.org/Sea-Tac/Pages/default.aspx.

Seattle, Washington is in the Pacific Time Zone.

Ground Transportation

Public Transportation: The Seattle Central Link light rail provides access to downtown Seattle from SEA airport. Trains leave SEA every 15 minutes, and the ride is approximately 38 minutes each way. Fares are \$3.50 one-way. The hotel is located near the Westlake stop.

Directions from SEA to the hotel using the Central Link:

- At SEA follow signs for Light Rail to Seattle.
- Exit at the Westlake stop (this stop is approximately a 10-minute walk to the hotel).
- From the Westlake station, walk east on Pine Street towards 7th Avenue. Turn right on 7th Avenue.
- Follow 7th Avenue for one block to Pike Street. Turn left on Pike Street. Follow Pike Street to the corner of Terry Avenue and Pike Street. The total distance is approximately 0.4 miles.

Taxi: Taxi fare between SEA and the hotel is approximately \$45 each way, not including gratuity.


Parking: Parking is available at the hotel for \$45 per night plus tax for self-parking. This includes in and out privileges. There is no valet parking.

Shared Ride Service: Shared ride services such as Uber and Lyft are available from SEA to the hotel. Fare ranges from \$40 to \$53 one way, depending on the time of day and not including gratuity. Walking Directions to EPA Region 10 office from the Homewood Suites hotel Approximately 0.5 miles, 9 minutes

- Exit the hotel on Pike Street. Head west towards Terry Avenue.
- Follow Pike Street to Sixth Avenue. Turn left on Sixth Avenue.
- EPA Region 10 will be located on the left at 1200 Sixth Avenue (Park Place Building).
