## Ground Transportation

**RTD Rail System:** Denver's RTD Rail System provides service from DEN to downtown Denver. Upon arriving at DEN, head to baggage claim located on Level 5. To get to the Denver Airport RTD Station, follow signs to the Transit Center and proceed to the south exit on level 5 (look for the large American flag), exit the terminal through the sliding glass doors and take the escalator located in the center of the plaza down to Level 1. The A Line Trains depart to and from the airport every 15 minutes throughout the day, 7 days a week, and 365 days a year. Early morning and late evening trips depart every 30 minutes. One-way fares are \$10.50. You must purchase your ticket prior to boarding the train from one of the kiosks located on the platform. To get to the hotel, take the A Line all the way to Union Station (approximately 37 minutes). From Union Station exit the station onto the 16<sup>th</sup> Street Mall. Follow 16<sup>th</sup> Street southeast until Champa Street. Turn right on Champa Street. Turn left on 15<sup>th</sup> Street to reach the hotel.

**Taxi:** Taxi fare between DEN and the Home2 by Hilton - Denver Downtown is approximately \$65 each way, not including gratuity.

**Hotel Parking:** Parking is available at the hotel for a discounted rate of \$30 per night plus tax for self-parking.

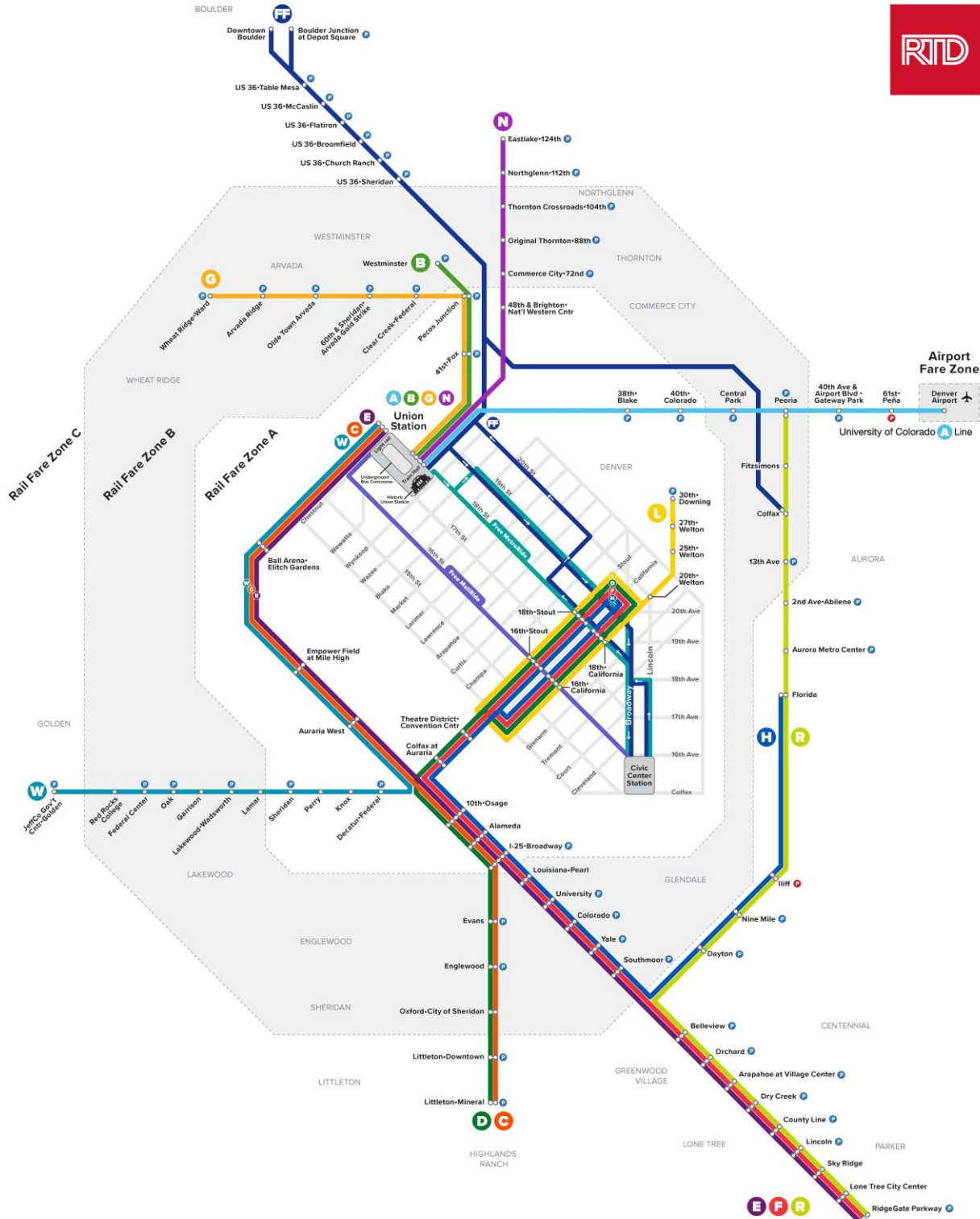
## Walking Directions to EPA Region 8 from the Home2 by Hilton - Denver Downtown
