

### U.S. Environmental Protection Agency CERCLA Education Center Superfund 101 May 6 through 10, 2024



#### **Schedule of Events**

The Superfund 101 training course will be held Monday, May 6 through Friday, May 10, 2024, at the EPA Region 10 office in Seattle, Washington. The training begins at 8:30 a.m. local time on Monday and ends at 3:00 p.m. local time on Friday. Please plan your travel accordingly.

The EPA Region 10 office is located at: 1200 Sixth Avenue Seattle, Washington 98101

Please note: The training will be held at the EPA Region 10 office in Seattle, Washington on the 21<sup>st</sup> floor. A sleeping room block has been established at Kimpton Hotel Monaco Seattle, which is located approximately 0.2 miles from the EPA Region 10 building, an approximately five-minute walk. For those driving to the training, paid parking is available in the EPA Region 10 building (Park Place building) with preferred stalls available for alternative fuel vehicles.

Hotel check-in begins after 3:00 p.m., and check-out time is at 12:00 p.m.

#### What to Pack for the Seattle Area

Average temperatures in May in Seattle range from 39°F at night to 54°F during the day. Please be advised that the temperatures in the training room do not reflect temperatures outside. Be sure to pack a jacket or sweater to wear while you attend the training.

#### **Travel Information**

The Seattle area is served by Sea-Tac International Airport (SEA). SEA is located approximately 15 miles from downtown Seattle, Washington and approximately 13 miles from the hotel. #### **Ground Transportation**

**Public Transportation:** The Seattle Central Link light rail provides access to downtown Seattle from SEA airport. Trains leave SEA every 15 minutes, and the ride is approximately 38 minutes each way. Fares are \$3.50 one-way. The hotel is located near the University Street stop.

Directions from SEA to the hotel using the Central Link:

- At SEA follow signs for Light Rail to Seattle.
- Exit at the University Street stop (this stop is approximately a five-minute walk to the hotel).
- Exit the station onto University Street. Head northeast towards Fourth Avenue.
- Turn right on Fourth Avenue.

Taxi: Taxi fare between SEA and the hotel is approximately \$41 each way, not including gratuity.


**Parking:** Valet parking is available at the hotel for \$60 per night plus tax for self-parking.

**Shared Ride Service:** Shared ride services such as Uber and Lyft are available from SEA to the hotel. Fare ranges from \$40 to \$53 one way, depending on the time of day and not including gratuity. # Walking Directions to EPA Region 10 office from the hotel Approximately 0.2 miles, 6 minutes

- Exit the hotel on Fourth Avenue.
- Head northwest towards Seneca Street.
- Turn right on University Street and follow to the intersection with Sixth Avenue.
- EPA Region 10 will be located on the right at 1200 Sixth Avenue (Park Place Building).
