Sleeping Room Reservations

What to Pack for the Chicago Area

Average temperatures in October range from 45°F at night to 63°F during the day. Please be advised that the temperatures in the training room do not reflect temperatures outside. Be sure to pack a jacket or sweater to wear while you attend the training.

Dining

The hotel includes an on-site British-style pub, Elephant & Castle, offering classic English and American fare. The pub serves lunch and dinner daily. Complimentary coffee, tea, and snacks are available in the Club Living Room lounge on weekdays. Restaurant options are nearby.

Travel Information

The Chicago area is served by O'Hare International Airport (ORD), and Chicago Midway International Airport (MDW).

Chicago, IL, is in the Central Time Zone.

Ground Transportation

The Chicago Transit Authority (CTA) provides access to downtown Chicago from O'Hare Airport via the Blue Line train, which runs 24/7 and takes approximately 45 minutes to reach the Loop. From Midway Airport, the Orange Line train connects to downtown in about 25 minutes. Additional information about the CTA is available at www.transitchicago.com

Taxi fare from O'Hare to downtown Chicago is metered and typically ranges from \$35 to \$50, not including tolls, peak-time surcharges, or gratuity. Taxi fare from Midway to downtown ranges from \$30 to \$40 under similar conditions.

Parking is available at InterPark – South Loop located at 318 South Federal Street. The garage is open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, and costs \$25 for 24 hours.

Walking Directions to EPA Region 5 from the Club Quarters Hotel, Central Loop

Approximately 0.1 miles, 3 minutes:

- ❖ Head east on West Adams Street toward South Clark Street.
- ❖ Turn Right on South Clark Street.
- ❖ Turn left on West Jackson Boulevard, the EPA building will be on your right at the corner of S Clark St and W Jackson Blvd.
