Please note: The training will be held at the EPA Region 7 office in Lenexa, Kansas. A sleeping room block has been established at the Courtyard Kansas City Olathe, which is located approximately 2.0 miles from the EPA Region 7. Parking is available at the hotel and at EPA Region 7 at no charge.

A block of rooms has been reserved at the Holiday Inn Kansas City Olathe in Olathe, Kansas. The lodging rate is \$135 per night plus tax which is the prevailing government rate.



Reservations must be made by March 3, 2025. When making a reservation, you can call the hotel at (913) 839-4500 and ask for the EPA Sampling Room Block. You are responsible for cancelling your hotel reservation if you cannot attend. **The hotel requires a notice of cancellation 48 hours prior to the day of your scheduled arrival by 3pm local time.** If you fail to provide notice, one night's lodging and tax will be charged to your credit card.

Hotel check-in begins after 3:00 p.m., and check-out time is at 11:00 a.m.

What to Pack for the Lenexa Area

Average temperatures in March in Lenexa range from 56°F during the day to 34°F at night. Please be advised that the temperatures in the training room do not reflect temperatures outside. Be sure to pack a jacket or sweater to wear while you attend the training.

Travel Information

The Lenexa area is served by the Kansas City International Airport (MCI). MCI is located approximately 35 miles from the hotel. Additional information for MCI is available at https://flykc.com/.

Ground Transportation

Taxi: Taxi fare between MCI and the hotel is approximately \$70 each way, not including gratuity.

SuperShuttle: SuperShuttle offers transportation to and from the hotel. The rate is approximately \$75 each way, not including gratuity. See https://www.supershuttle.com/ for additional details and reservations.

Shared Ride Service: Shared ride services such as Uber and Lyft are available from MCI to the hotel. Fare ranges from \$40 to \$60 one way, depending on the time of day and not including gratuity. For pick-up, follow the signs to the Arrivals commercial curb and look for the purple signposts 2K-N.

Driving Directions to the Courtyard Kansas City Olathe from MCI Airport (Approximately 35 miles)

- From the airport, get on I-29 S/US-71 S in May Township from Cookingham Dr and N 120th St.
- Follow I-29 S/US-71 S, I-635 S and I-35 S to W 119th Street in Olathe. Take exit 220 from I-35 S.
- Continue on W 119th Street. Take S Strang Line Rd to S Strang Line Ct. The destination will be on the left.

Driving Directions from the Holiday Inn Express Olathe North to the EPA Region 7 Office

(Approximately 2.1 miles, 10-minute drive)

- Leave the hotel area and head north towards S Strang Line Ct.
- Continue onto S Strang Line Ct. Turn right on S Strang Line Rd
- Turn left onto W 119th St. Turn right on Renner Blvd, followed by another right turn at the EPA region 7 office. The destination will be on the left.
