Ground Transportation

Regional Transportation District (RTD): The RTD public transit system provides access to the Denver area. The RTD, light rail system, opens at 5:00am and closes at 1:00am each day. Trains run approximately every five to nine minutes during the weekday rush hour and approximately every eight to 20 minutes, depending on the time of day. Fare is \$2.40 each way.

You may purchase an RTD Mobile Ticket or a physical ticket. The RTD Mobile Ticket is a digital, stored-value option that allows riders to pay the standard fare conveniently through the MyRide app. It's available for purchase online at any time. The physical ticket is a paper stored-value card or single-ride ticket available at over 150 ticket vending machines located at stations and at participating retail outlets throughout the Denver metro area

From **DEN**, take the **A Line** commuter rail to **Union Station**. The hotel is about a 10- to 15-minute walk from Union Station:

- Follow signs for the 16th Street Mall / Wynkoop Street exit at Union Station.
- Exit Union Station onto Wynkoop Street and head southwest toward 16th Street Mall.
- Turn left onto 16th Street Mall and walk approximately 0.6 miles and then turn right onto Champa Street.
- Continue for about 0.1 miles; the hotel will be on the right at 1725 Champa Street.

Taxi: Taxi fare between Denver International Airport and the hotel is approximately \$60 to \$75 each way, not including gratuity.


Uber/Lyft: Fare between Denver International Airport and the hotel typically ranges from \$40 to \$70 one way, not including gratuity.

Hotel Parking: Parking is available for hotel guests at the Residence Inn by Marriott Denver City Center. The hotel offers self-parking with no in-and-out privileges. The current rate is approximately \$35 per 24-hour period. Rates and availability may vary, so it's recommended to check with the hotel upon arrival for the most up-to-date information.
